

Maintenance recommendations for household appliances



- For the **iron**, use distilled water from the clothes dryer to prevent it from getting clogged (standard procedure),
- For **taps**, wipe a cloth (if necessary, with white vinegar) every 15-30 days at the outlet of your taps (this is a standard maintenance), immerse the faucet aerator in white vinegar,
- For **shower heads**, soak them every 6 months in white vinegar (this is standard maintenance).
- For **kettles or coffee machines**, do not allow the water to boil at 100 ° C (60-70 ° C is clearly sufficient), because water vapor tends to precipitate limescale. Renew the water for each boil + regularly clean the bottom of the container with white vinegar to descale it. This is a standard maintenance depending on the interior coating of the devices,
- Regarding the **dishwasher**, standard maintenance: program the washings at max 55 ° C !, add: rinsing liquid (cleaner & degreaser), dishwasher tablets for the shine of the glasses, regenerating salt ; regular cleaning of the dishwasher filter; in case of very hard water, use crystallized citric acid (in combination with the tablets).
- For **shower screens** (normal cleaning),
- Water **decanters**, clean the bottom with white vinegar or citric acid in water,
- For the **washing machine** you can continue to use a softener (but it will be less necessary thanks to the Biodynamizer).
- For **steam ovens**, check with the supplier its compatibility with non-softened water (which is the case with dynamized water) and follow its maintenance recommendations
- For **boilers, water heaters**, please set them to a maximum of 55 ° C
- In general, please set your **hot water devices** to a maximum of 55 ° C
